

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

A gift that a church can provide is a sacred space to acknowledge milestones. We celebrate births, baptisms, birthdays, confirmations, new members, marriages, retirements, and the lives of those who have gone tenderly to eternity. Sometimes much of the meaning of our lives happens between milestones, but meaningful markers serve portals of purpose and can be special gifts.

As I write, I sit in a pew, waiting for the start of memorial service. It is for my childhood pastor who served 27 years in my home church, in Boulder, Colorado. They are expecting 900 people. The flood of memories and the recognition of familiar faces is filling my heart. I just hugged my confirmation sponsors who are now in their eighties and was scolded by a former Sunday School teacher for giving her a hard time 38 years go. She just forgave me. This milestone of celebrating Pastor Bruce's life is a poignant reminder of the power of milestones. The most influential pastor in my growing up has gone to be with God.

Our Second Church community just experienced two notable milestones. We recently said goodbye to the Rev. Carlos López, our pastor from 1962-1968. We not only surround his sister Reina with love and prayer, but I know that for many, the thought of Carlos conjures precious memories. His passion and faith touched so many. He was always a kind friend to me and kept tabs on out congregation all these years.

We also recently celebrated the 128th birthday/anniversary of our church. It was at a Presbytery meeting in Socorro that our congregation was voted into existence. It has been a place of ministry and mission that has touched so many lives for so many years. And we are blessed to be a part of giving and receive blessings of the community for many years to come. We all connect to the congregation from different vantages, but it serves as a place of faith, hope, love and God's Spirit that touches us all.

One more milestone on the horizon, and one we will celebrate with people all over the world is the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation. The actual anniversary is October 31 and we will be sure to acknowledge it during the year. It is a significant milestone, that along with so many others, blesses our lives with meaning.

NEEDED: Children's Choir Director (Paid Position)

The Children's Choir program at Second Presbyterian Church was created in 2014, for 3 to 12 children from four years through 4th grade. It has on occasion included 15+ children, but that is not typical. Rehearsals are 30 to 40 minutes in length each Sunday, beginning at approximately 11:30 a.m. The Children's Children Choir sings in worship every 4 to 6 weeks, usually on 1st Sundays when the children are in attendance at the entire worship service. Planning is done "seasonally" (Advent/ Christmas/Lent Easter, etc.) with the minister and music director, with other opportunities as the Children's Director sees fit.

Children's Participation in Worship

Our Christian Educators took a survey from our young Church School participants regarding their interest with assisting in various areas of worship. In addition to their monetary pledge, their range of interest ran from serving as lay leaders, singing in the choir, ushering, greeters, and serving communion.

The Worship and Music Committee will continue to coordinate the participation of our youth and children in worship with the Christian Education Department.

February Worship and Ash Wednesday Planning

The Worship and Music Committee met recently to plan for the month of February and to look ahead at the Lenten Season which begins on Ash Wednesday, March 1. MISSION - Anna Torres

The Martin Luther King, Jr. Multicultural Council Scholarship Celebration was held on Monday, January 16, 2017 at Congregational Albert. Martha Powers, Anna Torres, Gloria Mirabal and Jack Torres attended on behalf of Second Presbyterian Church. This year's recipient of the \$1,000 scholarship is Angeles Ruby Castorena, a senior at Manzano High School. She plans to attend NM Eastern University to study Forensics. Second Presbyterian Church has sponsored a student for over 10 years.





Susie Chang has requested that Second Presbyterian Church participate in the Meals on Wheels Program by taking a route delivering meals. Volunteers would take a route once a month for about one and a half hours to deliver these meals. Our responsibility would be to pick up prepared meals and deliver to homes. Susie Chang will present this request at the February 5 Sunday morning service.

Pastor Rob and Martha Powers attended a meeting on Sunday, January 15 at First Presbyterian Church held to recruit participants for the mission trip to Guatamala in May. Deadline to apply is January 31, 2017. Second Presbyterian Church has participated in this mission trip to Guatamala for 12 years.

Pastor Beidy from our partner church in Matanzas, Cuba has requested Sunday School materials for children. Beidy acquired curriculum materials when she was in Albuquerque two years ago and would like to continue using this same curriculum. She currently has materials to cover her until April 2017.

The Martineztown Community is continuing to meet to contest a zoning plan that may change the atmosphere and safety of the community by allowing commercial zoning.

Members of Second Presbyterian Church prepared and delivered twelve chicken casseroles to St. Martin's Hospitality Center for Project Share on Christmas Eve.
